**Rules:**

- The Yarmouth Sailing Invitational Regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020*, the *prescriptions of the US Sailing Association*, and the applicable Class regulations.

**1. Eligibility and Entry:**

- a) The Races are open to all boats complying with the class regulations of the following class:
  - 420
- b) Participants shall not have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2019
- c) Each competitor must submit:
  - Medical form
  - Consent and Release form
  - Entry form
- d) Fees:
  - \$40 Per participant payable by Cash, Check or Credit Card:

**2. Notice to Competitors**

- Official notices to competitors will be posted on the Notice Board at Yarmouth Sailing Center. It is the responsibility of each participant to check the Notice Board for information prior to racing.

**3. Sailing Instructions**

- Available at the Sailing Center on the day of the event

**4. Schedule**

- The Yarmouth Sailing 420 Invitational will be held Thursday August 8<sup>th</sup> 2019
- 0800 - Registration & snack
- 0900 – Skipper’s Meeting
- 1000 – First race warning gun
- Last race will start no later than 1330hrs.
- Lunch and awards will be at the Sailing Center after the last race.

**5. Venue:**

- The starting area will be located on the south side of Englewood beach. There will be one starting line.

**6. Courses:**

- The courses to be sailed will be communicated as detailed in the Sailing Instructions and will normally be selected from those shown in the attached course sheet.
- Marks will be inflatable orange and/or yellow marks

**7. Penalty system:**

- As governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020*

**8. Scoring:**

- Scoring will be the “Low Point” system of the RRS Annex A, if 6 or more races are held the lowest score will be dropped

**9. Prizes:**

- Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third finishers in 420
- Prizes for sportsmanship may be awarded

**10. Personal Floatation Device (PFD)**

- Other than brief periods of adding or removing clothing, all competitors shall wear a properly fitting US Coast Guard approved non-inflatable Personal Floatation Device (PFD) while on the water.

**11. Coaching**

- Any coach/observer who violates rule 41 by providing outside coaching to a competitor while racing will subject the competitor to protest and disqualification.
- All coach/observers shall remain 30 meters from the racing area until competitors have finished
- The Race Committee **will** enforce rule 41 violations
- In the event of any safety issues, all coaches in the racing area are encouraged and expected to offer assistance

**Entry fee:** \$40.00 per Sailor
